THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING:

Usable Household Items

- Clothing (clean, no rips or tears)
- Small working appliances
- Shoes, purses, belts, hats
- Household goods
- Hardware & tools
- Knickknacks
- Kitchen utensils, dishes
- and much more!

These items will be donated to Vietnam Veterans of America. Receipts will be available, and it is recommended that you itemize donated items on a separate sheet of paper that can be attached to your receipt. For items not listed above, contact City Hall.

Trees & Branches: Tree limbs and brush no longer than 8 feet and no larger than 6 inches in diameter will be accepted for chipping. Later in the Spring, wood chips will be available. *This service is for Ham Lake Residents only!*

Car batteries – no monetary redemption provided.

Fluorescent light bulbs – 4' and under: 50¢ charge, 5' and over: 70¢ charge

Scrap Metals – No plastic, wood or rubber attached. No monetary redemption provided.

Electronics & computers (NEW PRICING!!)

- Computer/Laptop, Monitor, TV/Plasma TV, VCR/DVD Player, Copier, Fax Machine, Printer
- Stereo, Vacuum Cleaner, Scanner, Telephone, etc.

All items are 29¢ a LB.

- Tin
- Cast Iron
- Stainless steel
- Snowmobiles (hoods & tracks must be removed)
- No propane tanks accepted

Appliances - \$10 charge, Including but not limited to:

- Refrigerators
- Water heaters
- Washers
- Microwave ovens
- Dehumidifiers
- Dishwashers
- Humidifiers
- Gas refrigerators (\$175 charge)
- RV gas refrigerators (\$75 charge)
- Freezers
- Stoves
- Stove tops
- Trash compactors
- Residential furnaces
- Dryers
- Air conditioners (\$15 charge)
- Water softeners (\$15 charge)

Tires

- Passenger car tires - \$1 with or without rims
- Truck tires - \$6 without rims, \$7 with rims
- Tractor tires - \$25, \$35 on wheels
