FRIDAY UPDATE: 03.03.18 – 03.09.18

Last week a resident in Ham Lake received a suspicious email and called a deputy. This isn't always normal, but the caller was 91 years old and had a concern so we were happy to assist. The deputy viewed the email which was sent from her "friends" email account – this friend regularly emails the caller. In the email, the friend was asking the caller to purchase two \$100 prepaid cards for her, take pictures of the card numbers, and pin codes - then email her the photos. The caller said this wasn't normal behavior so she contacted our office. The deputy called the friend who said her email account was hacked. If you receive an email like this from a "friend" always verify with the friend before doing anything – we don't recommend just hitting the reply button either. We recommend starting a new email and sending it, or picking up the phone and speaking with them. They may not know that their account got hacked.
