FRIDAY UPDATE: 07.14.17-07.21.17

We received information today from the Anoka County Community Action Program about a phone call they received at their office. It was left on a phone that isn't publicly listed and we wanted to share it with you in case you receive something similar.

Call was received at ACCAP on an extension phone for our program that is not published publicly.

The caller ID said:
Garden City, New York
1-516-253 or 256-7513

The computer call started out with Welcome this is Publishers clearing house call about your winnings, then it goes to another voice stating, "this is your final notice from PCH claims department to inform you about your winnings. We have sent 2 notifications of your cash award back unsigned and we would like to clear up this matter, please call 1-888-406-8977."

We called the number and it goes to a voicemail prompt system and sounds pretty legit. However, all the prompts lead you to a message that says "we are experiencing high call volume right now so please leave your name and number and we will call you back." My guess is they do this so the scammers know who may be a good target. Just delete the message – unfortunately none of us will probably win the real Publisher Clearing House Sweepstakes 😊
