Investigator Insight: It looks like the thieves enjoyed last week's warm weather as much as we did! There was an obvious increase in thefts from vehicles, mailboxes, yards and homes. We want to remind everyone to be vigilant - if you see anything suspicious please call 911. Be specific about what you are witnessing and try to get good descriptions of vehicles and people. On vehicles, a license plate is always best - but even the make, model, color and direction of travel will help. When describing people, include a description of their clothing, hair, build type, and unique identifying characteristics. If vehicles are parked suspiciously in business lots after the business is closed - we would like to know that too. Don't hesitate to call - when we partner together we become better.
