**FRIDAY UPDATE: 04.13.18**

This past week we have received MULTIPLE reports about the IRS scam. This is where someone calls and says you owe the IRS money - and if you do not pay them you will be arrested. Most people know that it is a scam and hang-up, but we have had a few people send money. We are assuming that this will continue until after "tax season."

Please continue to tell all your friends, family, social groups, etc. about this scam – and advise them to not respond. If you have been a victim or received a call like this - you can report it at <https://www.ic3.gov/default.aspx>. This is a federal website that gathers information on these scammers and works to shut them down!
