FRIDAY UPDATE: 12.22.17-12.29.17

SAFE ICE: Don't forget this winter these general ice thickness guidelines.

2" or less	STAY OFF
4"	Ice fishing or other activities on foot
5"	Snowmobile or ATV
8" - 12"	Car or small pickup
12" - 15"	Medium truck

**Note: these guidelines are for new, clear solid ice.*

Many factors other than thickness can cause ice to be unsafe. White ice or "snow ice" is only about half as strong as new clear ice. Double the above thickness guidelines when traveling on white ice.
