Investigator Insight: It's tax season! Just wanted to send out a few reminders and tip in hopes that you will do everything you can to protect yourself. Be sure to choose your tax preparer carefully, double check that your incoming mail is secure, follow up if you don't receive expected paperwork, don't believe just anyone who says they're from the IRS. Also, dispose of your paperwork carefully by shredding it and if filing online make sure your antivirus software is updated. If you are mailing your returns, mail it from a secure US Postal box.
