Upcoming Defensive Driving Courses for 2023 are being held by MHSRC (Minnesota Highway Safety Research Center)

For those 55 and older. Registration required. You will need to call **1-888-234-1294** to register for classes or go to <u>https://www.stcloudstate.edu/continuingstudies/mhrc/55-</u> <u>plus/default.aspx</u>

4 Hour Refresher Course: You need to take this every 3 years and time flies so make sure you are current. The fee is \$24 for the 4 hour class.

Friday, September 15th - 11am to 3pm Friday, November 10th - 12pm to 4pm

8 Hour First Time Course: Required if you haven't taken the course previously. None Scheduled at this time.

If you are 55 or over and take these courses, state law requires that your insurance company give you a 10% discount if you take and 8 hour Defensive Driving Course and attend a 4 hour refresher course every 3 years. We are planning a trip to the apple orchard on September 14. There is an interest sheet at the senior center. Please sign up . The cost is \$21 which includes lunch and transportation. Will leave center at 10:30 AM.

PROTECT YOUR CREDIT To keep others from opening accounts in your name, put a credit freeze on your accounts at all three credit bureaus. Experian. TransUnion, Equifax Then if anyone tries to open a charge account, bank account or loan in your name, it will be stopped. They have to ask your permission.

The following is from the commerative event.

PLEASE LET ME INTRODUCE COMRADE JOHN LESLIE CLINTON. JOHN IS A MEMBER OF OUR VFW POST HERE AT PALMER LAKE VFW. WE ARE HERE TONIGHT TO PRESENT JOHN WITH MEDALS HE EARNED OVER 55 YEARS AGO THAT HE NEVER RECEIVED.

TONIGHT JOHN WILL BE PRESENTED WITH THE ARMED FORCES EXPEDITIONARY MED-AL AND THE KOREAN DEFENSE SERVICE MEDAL..

LET ME TAKE YOU ALL BACK TO SOUTH KOREA OVER 55 YEARS AGO. JANUARY 23, 1968 THE U.S.S. PUEBLO WAS BOARDED AND CAPTURED BY THE NORTH KOREANS. THE PUEBLO WAS TOWED INTO PORT IN NORTH KOREA AND ITS ENTIRE CREW PUT IN PRISON. THINGS RAPIDLY HEATED UP ALONG THE ENTIRE KOREAN PEN-NINSULA. JOHN WAS THERE AND THINGS WERE VERY TENSE ALL ALONG THE ENTIRE DMZ.

JOHN WAS DRAFTED AND REPORTED FOR DUTY 19 SEPTEMBER 1966. AFTER BASIC TRAINING HE REPORTED TO THE 2ND INFANTRY DIVISION ARTILLERY IN SOUTH KOREA. HE WAS AN OPERATIONS AND INTELLIGENCE SPECIALIST. JOHN MADE SERGEANT IN JUST 15 MONTHS. AFTER A DANGEROUS YEAR SERVED ALONG THE DMZ JOHN RE-TURNED HOME. HE RECEIVED HIS DD-214 AND A YOUNG INEXPERIENCED 2ND LT.DID THE INPUT AND PAPERWORK. NOTHING ON HIS DD-214 SHOWED THAT HE SPENT OVER A YEAR IN KOREA OR THE MEDALS THAT HE EARNED. NONE OF THIS REALLY SEEMED TO MATTER UNTIL JOHN NEEDED TO INQUIRE ABOUT VA HEALTH CARE. VET-ERANS WHO SERVED IN KOREA ARE ELIGIBLE FOR AGENT ORANGE BENEFITS AND HIS DD-214 SHOWED NO SERVICE IN KOREA. OUR VFW HELPED JOHN GET A DD-215 WHICH SHOWS HIS OVERSEAS SERVICE AND CAMPAIGN MEDALS THAT HE EARNED. THIS IS WHAT THE VFW DOES, IT'S VETERANS HELPING VETERANS. AFTER 55 YEARS, THE ARMY FINALLY SENT THE MEDALS THAT WE ARE PRESENTING HERE TODAY.
