FRIDAY UPDATE: 02.19.21

This week I moved the "unemployment fraud" calls to the *Call for Service* report. Just remember, if you do receive a letter or call about your identity being used to claim unemployment, you need to do the following:

- You won't know you are a victim of the scam until you receive a letter from MN Department of Employment and Economic Development (DEED) stating that they created an account for you, or they are denying your claim.
- If you are working, report the fraud to your human services department to document the incident.
- Contact DEED and let them know this is fraud DEED.CustomerService@state.mn.us or call 651.259.7114.
- Make a report with your local law enforcement agency.
- Review your credit report and possibly freeze your credit.

Andover

Thefts & Damage to Property

Arrests

- 02.15 Round Lake/Hwy 10 NW 3rd degree DWI; a deputy stopped a vehicle for driving without headlights at 1:14 am. When he made contact wit the driver, he appeared impaired. Field sobriety tests were conducted and failed. He was arrested. .245
- 02.15 2500 Block Bunker Lake Blvd NW -3^{rd} degree DWI; a deputy stopped a driver for speeding, almost hitting a road sign and two vehicles in a turn lane. When the deputy made contact, the male appeared confused and smelled of alcohol. Field sobriety tests were offered, but the driver was unable to follow any directions, so the tests were stopped for his safety and he was arrested. .377
- 02.15 7 Ave/Bunker Lake Blvd NW Drugs; a deputy stopped a driver for erratic behavior. When speaking with the driver, he stated he did not have a license. The passenger appeared to be trying to hide her purse. The deputy observed illegal drugs in her purse. The vehicle was searched and drugs and a large amount of cash was found. The driver was issued a citation for not having a license, the female passenger was arrested for drugs.
- 02.16 134xx Hwy 65 NE Warrant Arrest; a deputy observed a suspicious vehicle running in the parking lot. He made contact with the driver and passenger. Through investigation it was discovered passenger had a warrant. The female was located inside the building and arrested.
