Andover

Thefts & Damage to Property

- 09.05 157xx Makah St NW – several opened Amazon packages were found in the woods
- 09.06 142xx Inca St NW – theft from a construction site; thieves unplugged surveillance cameras
- 09.06 17xx Bunker Lake Blvd NW – theft of three tires off a vehicle parked at a business
- 09.07 172xx Verdin St NW – damage to mailbox
- 09.07 36xx 174 Ave NW – door on a shed kicked in; nothing stolen

Arrests

- 09.05 Round Lake/136 Ave NW – DWI, Controlled Substance; multiple callers reported a driver being reckless and almost hitting pedestrians. The deputy located the vehicle and stopped it. When he made contact with the driver he smelled marijuana and saw marijuana shake on the floor. Field sobriety tests were conducted and failed. The driver began doing push-ups which is odd. A warrant for blood was obtained. Drugs were found in the vehicle. He was arrested.
- 09.05 137xx Round Lake Blvd NW – Drugs; an employee called about a suspicious male hanging around the location and she was concerned because school was starting tomorrow. A deputy attempted to speak with the male, and he stated he doesn't want to talk; the male had two large visible knives on him. He did provide a false name to the deputy and then attempted to run. The deputy caught the male and back-up arrived. After a brief altercation the male was handcuffed and identified. He had two warrants and meth was found on him. He was arrested.
- 09.07 143xx Thrush St NW – Domestic Assault; deputies responded to a mother/son domestic where the son fled in a vehicle. The vehicle was located, and the suspect arrested.

Arrests

09.03 Hwy 65/Sims Rd NE – Warrant Arrest; a deputy stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. The driver was identified and found to have warrants. He was arrested.

09.08 237 Ave/Hwy 65 NE – Warrant Arrest; on routine patrol a deputy observed a driver and knew he had a warrant. He stopped the vehicle, and the driver was arrested.

Arrests

09.02 Bunker/Hwy 65 NE – Drugs; a deputy observed a vehicle trying to avoid him and he stopped it for an equipment violation. When he made contact with the driver, he saw paraphernalia and smelled marijuana. When asked if drugs would be found in the vehicle, the driver said no. The vehicle was searched and three bricks of marijuana, along with other drugs were located. The driver was arrested.

09.02 Hwy 65/169 Ave NE – Warrant Arrest; a deputy stopped a vehicle for having a license plate light out. The driver and passenger were identified. The driver did not have a driver's license and the passenger had a warrant. He was arrested.

09.05 Crosstown/Hwy 65 NE – 3rd degree DWI; a deputy observed a vehicle in a turn-lane and the driver standing outside the vehicle. He went to see if he could help. The driver fled when she saw the deputy. He eventually stopped her, and she appeared impaired and was combative – she is 17. She refused to do field sobriety tests. She was arrested. The suspect spoke with her father and agreed to do the DMT test. .13
