### **Scams**

There were no scams reported this week.

### **Andover**

#### **Thefts & Damage to Property**

10.24 157xx Kiowa St NW – mailbox damaged by a vehicle

### **Arrests**

10.22 24xx 135 Ave NW – Domestic Assault, Felony DANCO; deputies responded to a boyfriend/girlfriend domestic. The boyfriend had fled. After investigating, deputies learned the GF had an order for protection against the boyfriend. He was located and arrested.

10.24 135 Ave/Round Lake Blvd NW – 1<sup>st</sup> degree DWI; multiple people called in a driver who was "all over the road and in and out of the ditch." Deputies located the driver as he was pulling into a driveway. A deputy made contact and the driver appeared extremely intoxicated and there was an open bottle of vodka in the vehicle. Field sobriety tests were conducted and failed. He was arrested. .269

10.27 Main St/Northdale Blvd – False Information, Warrant; an Investigator observed a male driving and knew he had a felony warrant. He stopped the driver. The driver gave his brother's name and date of birth and could not provide any identification. Another deputy was called to verify the driver's identity. He was arrested.

10.27 49xx Marystone Blvd NW – 2<sup>nd</sup> degree DWI; a deputy responded to a property damage crash. When he made contact with the driver, the driver stated that he "got drunk and was lost." The deputy got him out of the vehicle, and he fell down so field sobriety tests could not be completed. He refused to PBT. After speaking to a lawyer, he took the breath test. He was arrested and charges were elevated due to a prior DWI. .26
