### **Scams**

11.07 The reporting party received a text message regarding his US Bank debit card. The message came from 847-874-7136 and stated his card had been locked and he needed to call to have it unlocked. The text message also included an email address to [online.banking.activity.alerts-709@eservices.com](mailto:online.banking.activity.alerts-709@eservices.com). He went to his bank in person to inquire about the text and found that nothing was wrong with his card. I called the number to see if I could speak to a person for him and received a prompt to enter a 16 digit card number. When seeing that the number was not recognized by the system it would not allow me to proceed further. I was unable to speak to a live person.

11.09 The reporting party stated that he met a lady, Lianny Mayers, on a fetish website named Telegram. He advised that they have been talking via this site for a short time. He advised that during their interactions via the site, Lianny asked if he could assist her with some money. He advised that he sent her approximately \$300. He used his PayPal account. He advised that Lianny stated that she needed the money to help her daughter whom he believes is the Jessica Baker. After sending her the money, she asked him to help her with funding her Crypto currency account. The victim advised that he received from a cashier's check in his name for the amount of \$1,825.00. He attempted to cash the check at Your Cash Exchange but was advised that the check was possibly fraudulent. He then took the check to his local bank who advised him that the check was fraudulent. I advised Travis him to shred the check and stop speaking with Lianny.

11.07 Bunker Lake/Hwy 65 NE – Obstructing Legal Process; a deputy observed an occupied vehicle on the side of the road and stopped to provide assistance. The driver rolled down her window and marijuana smoke billowed out. The driver said her car broke down and she was waiting for a friend. The deputy said that he was going to search the vehicle and if she wasn't lying he would just let her wait for her friend. The driver refused to get out of the vehicle and started fighting with the deputy. Another deputy was called to respond emergency. Eventually the female was restrained and arrested.
