At the Operations Committee meeting today, we discussed state legislation that could help modernize community TV funding and provide the Commission with new revenue.

This is from the Ops packet:

The North Metro Telecommunications Commission is working with MACTA, the lobbying firm Goff Public, and the League of Minnesota Cities to champion a pair of bills that will be introduced early in the 2024 Minnesota State Legislative Session. The bills collectively seek to modernize PEG funding by enabling city franchising of broadband internet providers and through a 5% fee on gross revenue for digital media streamers. The NMTC will be reaching out to state legislators, encouraging them to support the bills. Member cities can help by sending resolutions to their legislators showing support for the bills. There is a sample resolution on the following page.
