**FRIDAY UPDATE: 12.07.18**

We tend to see an increase in mail theft this time of year due to holiday cards that may contain checks, cash, or gift cards. We also take a lot of reports of packages being stolen from front doors. If you see a suspicious vehicle or person loitering around mailboxes and front doors, please call 911 immediately. A good description of the vehicle, along with the direction of travel and a license plate - if you can get it - is very helpful.

We ask that you don't put any outgoing mail in your mailbox; instead use a secured Post Office box or mail it from work. That extended red flag is an invitation to thieves. If you are expecting a package to be delivered, make sure you are home, have it delivered to work, or ask a neighbor to pick it up for you.
